Departments relay the collected information to a local American Legion post. The local post then contacts the service member or family to see how assistance can be provided locally.

Amount of assistance provided is only limited by an individual's valid need. Financial assistance may be used for emergency travel, health care expenses, rent or mortgage, rental deposits, minor home repairs, vehicle repairs, vehicle payments, utilities, funeral expenses, furniture, food and appliance maintenance.

Payments are made to vendors, mortgage companies, insurance carriers, apartment complexes, utility service companies, phone carriers and, occasionally, a direct payment to a qualified veteran for groceries and family incidentals. Gift cards can also be used in the Financial Assistance Program in lieu of cash payments by check.

A warrior household may be eligible for a one-time financial grant only when all other options have been exhausted. Requests for assistance can usually be fulfilled in two business days, and all payments will be made to a third party.
