FAMILY SUPPORT PROGRAMS



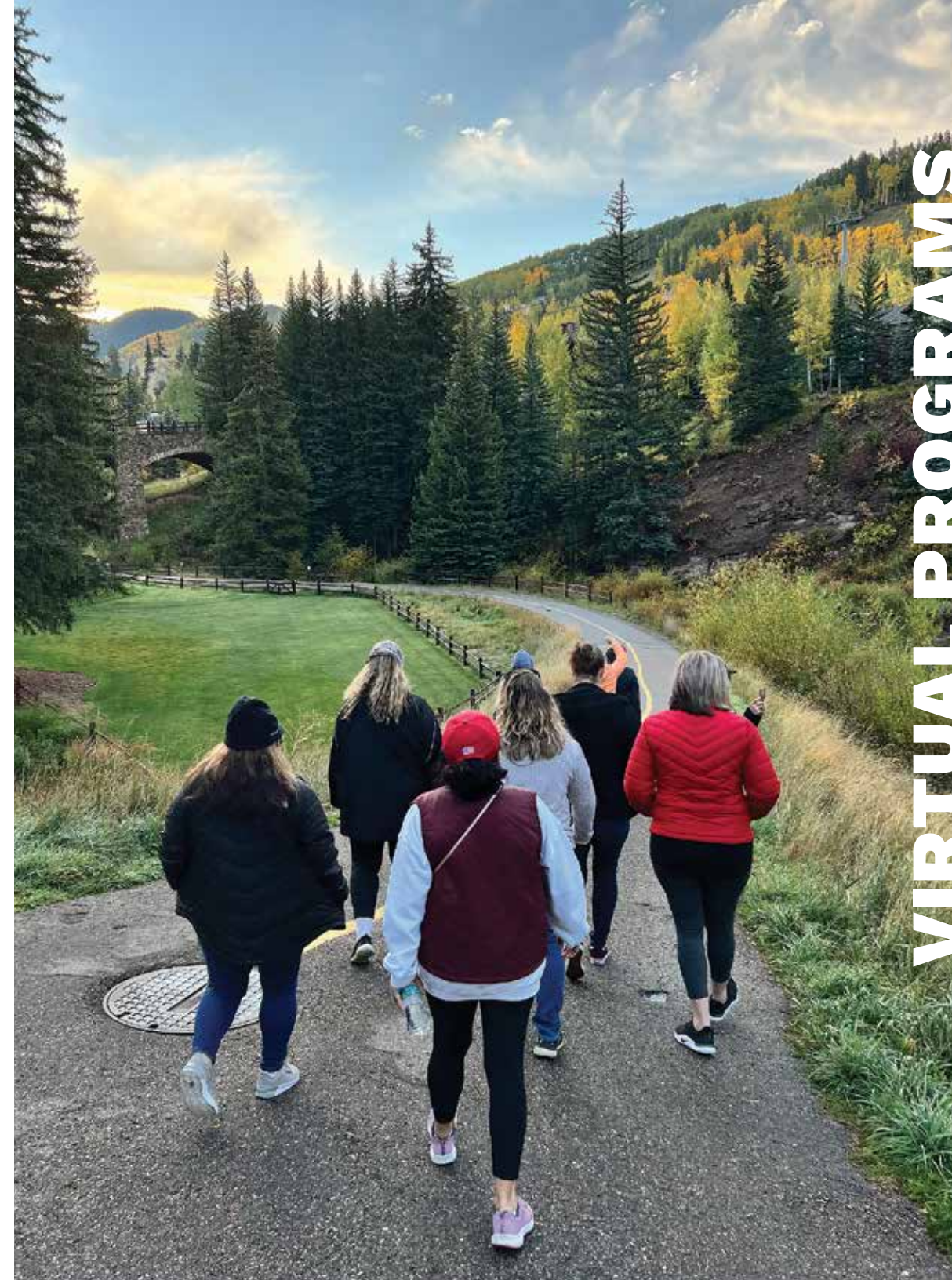
PHYSICAL, MENTAL AND EMOTIONAL WOUNDS OF WAR IMPACT THE ENTIRE FAMILY.

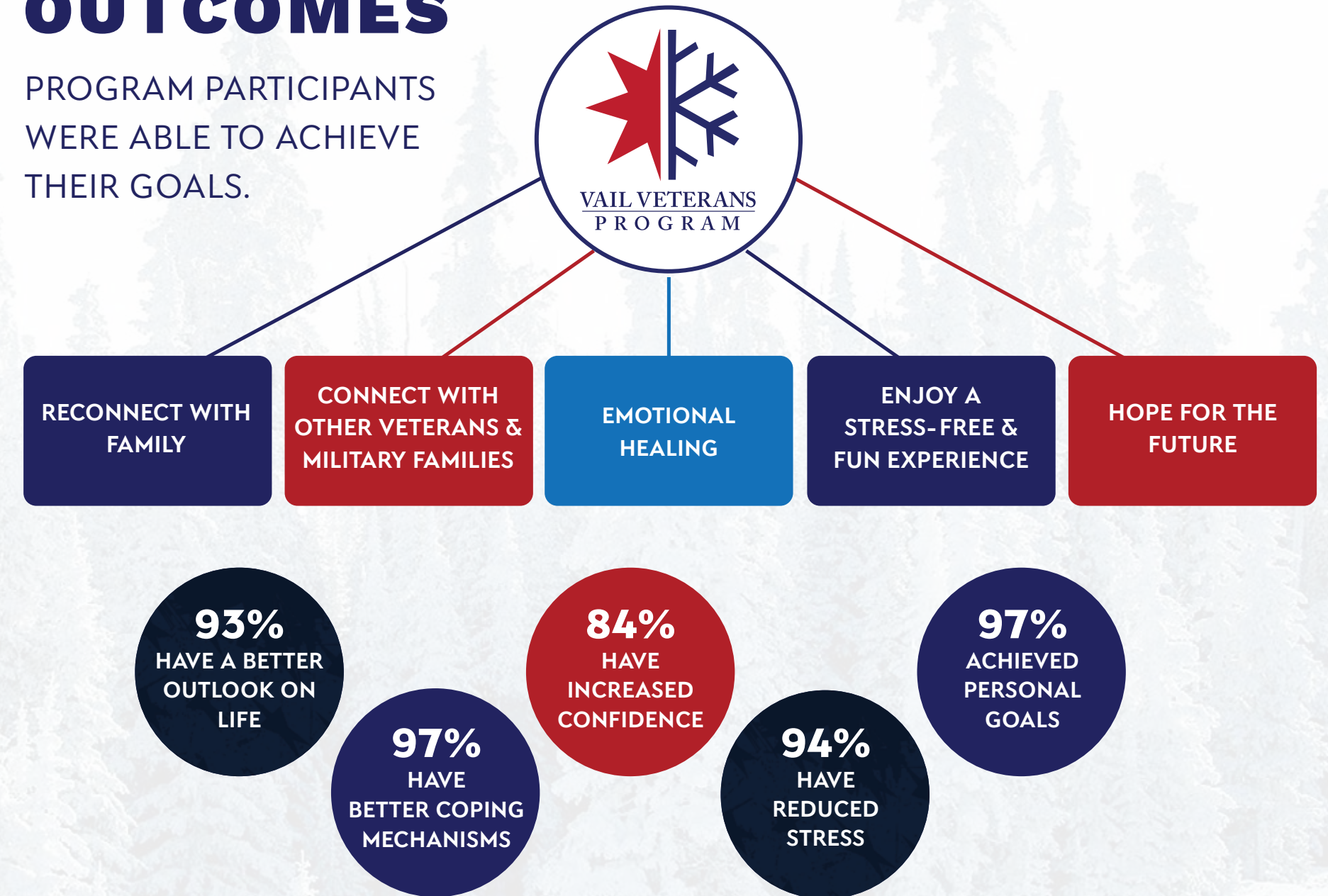

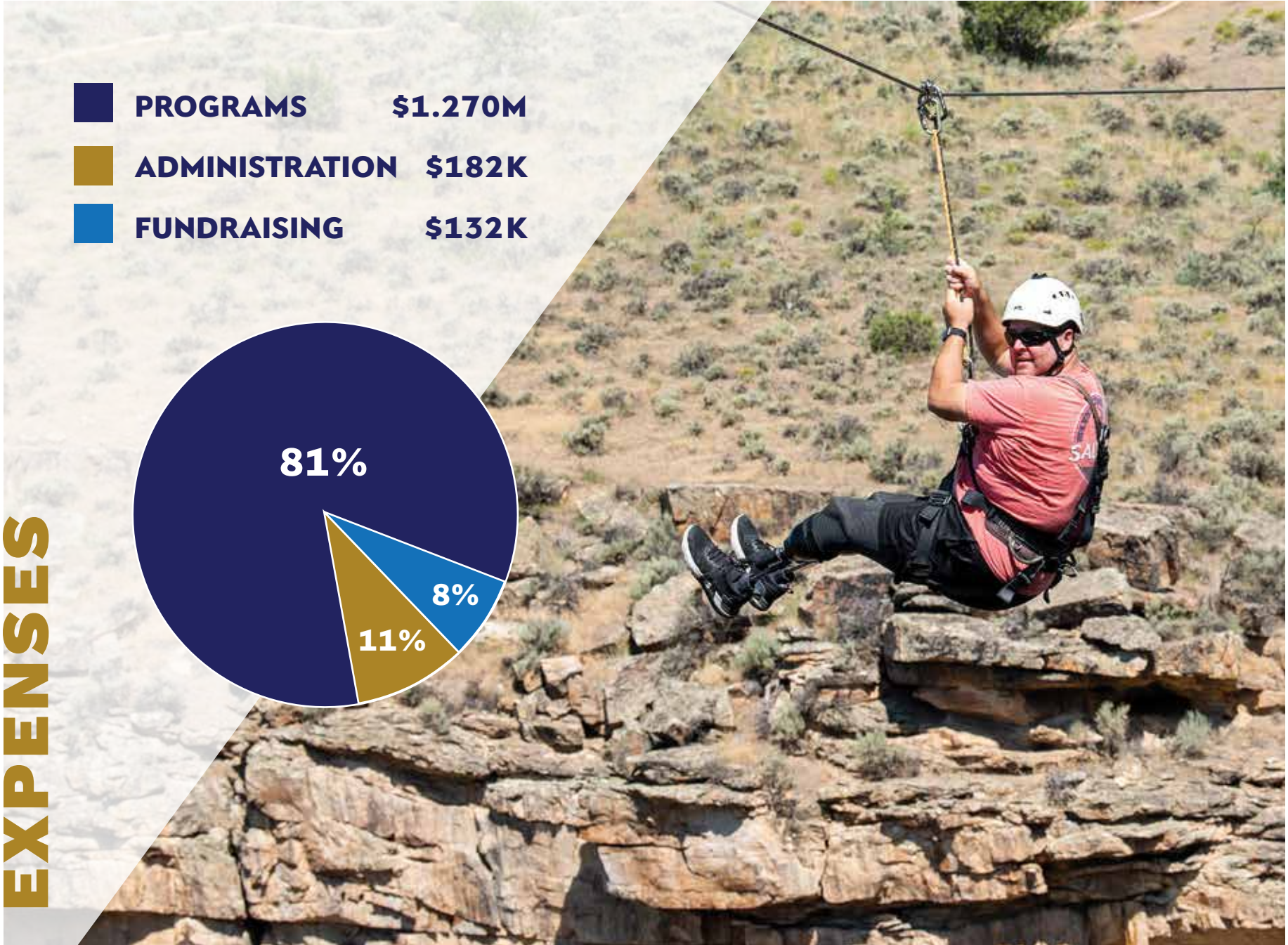
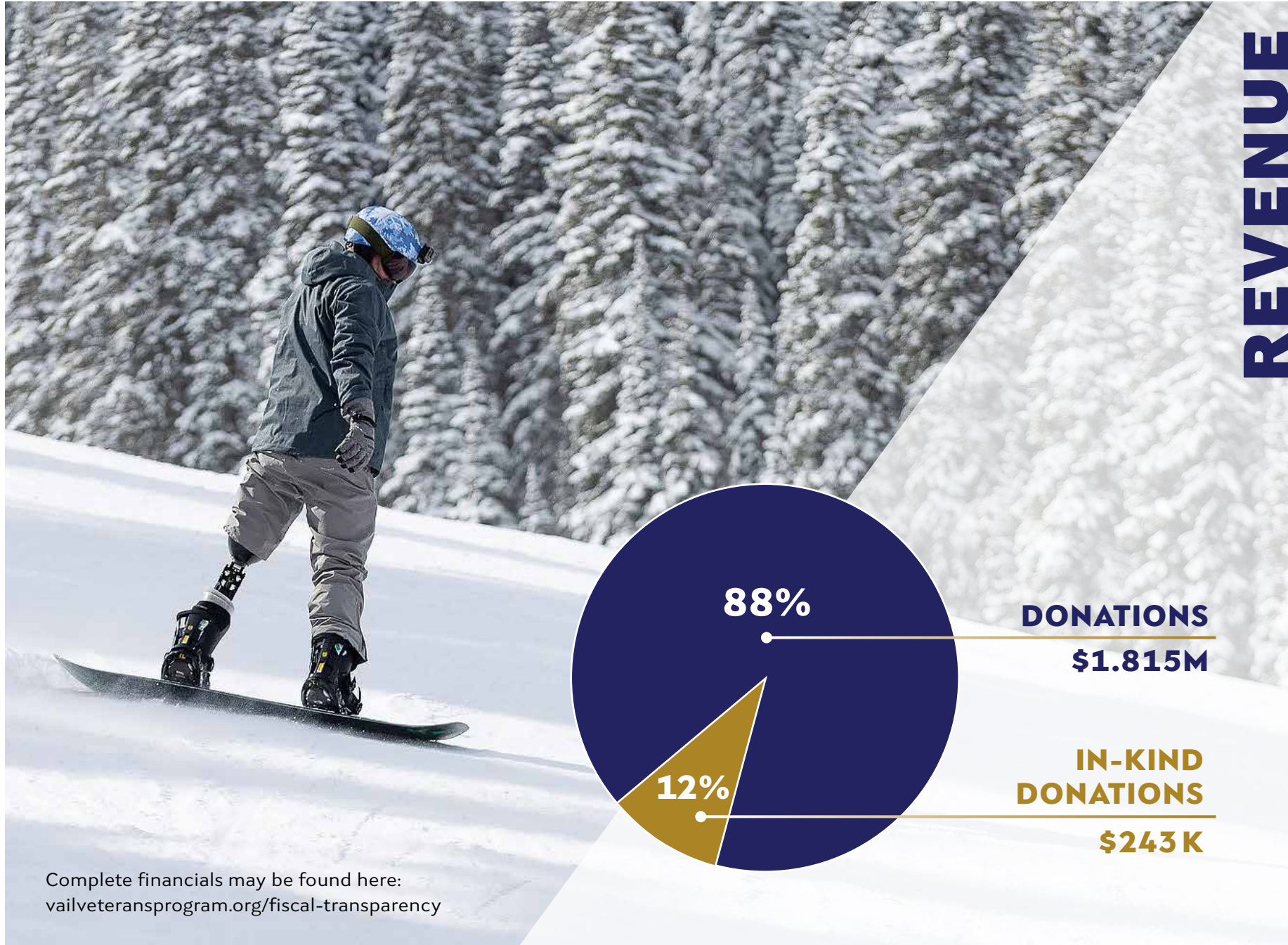
