<a href="#"><u>American Legion-Family Source Network Assistance Line</u></a>	Fill out form online to get email.	800-433-3318	Assistance calls are referred to The American Legion department, or state in which the call originated. Departments relay the collected information to a local American Legion post. The local post then contacts the service member or family to see how assistance can be provided locally.
<a href="#"><u>Army Emergency Relief</u></a>	Fill out form online to get email.	877-272-7337	Provides funds to relieve distress, often involving the basic essentials of everyday living, either in the form of a no-interest loan, a grant, or combination depending on the applicant's personal situation. The amount of assistance provided is only limited by an individual's valid need. Financial assistance may be used for emergency travel, health care expenses, rent or mortgage, rental deposits, minor home repairs, vehicle repairs, vehicle payments, utilities, funeral expenses, furniture, food and appliance maintenance.

Gift cards can also be used in the Financial Assistance Program in lieu of cash payments by check.

Can help with associate expenses including purchasing of special equipment, adaptive vans or vehicles, and handicap home purchases and modification.

The funding provided is coupled with our financial literacy program, to ensure that women vets don't find themselves in financial hardship again. Money distributed can be used to help the veteran remain in safe and suitable housing by stopping the eviction process, funding can also be used for paying first month rent and security deposits as well as rental and utility payments. In extreme cases funds can be used to provide food for women veterans and their children.
<u><a href="#">Wounded Warrior Project</a></u>	Fill out form online to get email.	877.TEAM.WWP (877-832-6997)	Wounded Warrior Project® (WWP) can provide emergency financial assistance to registered and approved warrior households for some, but not all, situations. A warrior household may be eligible for a one time financial grant only when all other options have been exhausted. Requests for assistance can usually be fulfilled in two to three business weeks, and all payments will be made to a third party.
